alifornia-based painter Laura Hipke invites us to look deeper into the human condition, using color and line to convey what she argues are universal truths that we often recognize but cannot describe. Her paintings, richly encoded with meaning, are intuitive portraiture that call to mind something from the past. Like looking through the lens of an old projector, we are transported into someone else's world, giving us a vague sense of voyeurism. The paintings in Looking Back at The Time and Space Gallery represent select pieces of her work created in the crucible of the last 5 years. They are moments of truth and clarity brought about by the solitary discipline of an inner pursuit.
